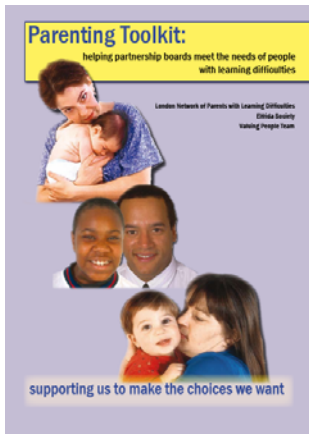


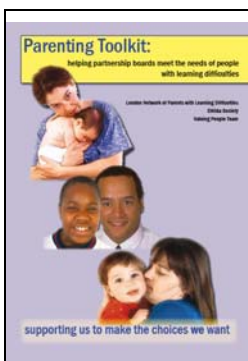
Parenting Toolkit Day
